- Managing services (systemd basics: start, stop, enable, disable)
- Understanding software repositories

04 Module 4: Essential System Configuration and Networking Basics

- Configuring network interfaces (IP addressing, DNS settings)
- Testing network connectivity (ping, ip, ss)
- Understanding log files and basic log management
- Managing storage and file systems (mount, df, du)

05 Module 5: Introduction to Shell Scripting

- Fundamentals of BASH scripting

- Variables, conditional statements, and loops in shell scripts
- Automating simple administrative tasks
- Debugging basic scripts
