FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What are the prerequisites for sitting the PMP certification exam after completing this course?

To be eligible for the PMP exam, candidates generally need either a four-year degree with at least 36 months of leading projects and 35 hours of project management education, OR a high school diploma/associate's degree with 60 months of leading projects and 35 hours of project management education. This 8-hour course contributes towards the 35 contact hours requirement, but students should verify their full eligibility with PMI before applying for the exam.

Q: How will this PMP course help me develop leadership skills specifically for diverse project teams?

This course places significant emphasis on the 'People' domain, covering crucial aspects like team leadership, conflict resolution, motivation, and effective communication strategies. You will learn to foster collaborative environments, empower team members, and manage stakeholder expectations across various project contexts, which are vital for leading diverse teams to successful project outcomes.
