FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the primary role of an SPC in an organization, and how does it differ from a SAFe Agilist?

An SPC acts as a change agent, leading and implementing SAFe transformations across an enterprise, whereas a SAFe Agilist typically participates within an Agile Release Train. SPCs are authorized to teach SAFe courses, launch and coach ARTs, and guide the strategic deployment of SAFe, providing a much broader and deeper impact on the organizational agile journey.

Q: What are the recommended prerequisites for someone considering the SAFe® Practice Consultant (SPC) certification?

While there are no strict prerequisites, it is highly recommended that candidates have significant experience in Agile (Scrum, Kanban, XP) and at least one SAFe certification (e.g., SAFe Agilist). Experience in leading or participating in a Lean-Agile transformation or a role in product management, project management, or leadership within an agile context is also highly beneficial for success in this advanced course.

Q: How does the SPC certification empower me to drive measurable business outcomes in large enterprises?

The SPC certification provides you with the frameworks, tools, and methodologies to establish and optimize value streams, synchronize multiple teams through Agile Release Trains (ARTs), and implement Lean Portfolio Management. You'll learn to identify organizational impediments, coach leaders and teams, and foster a culture of continuous improvement, directly contributing to faster time-to-market, improved quality, and enhanced employee engagement across the enterprise.
